Mark wasn't ready to get help. He was still in denial.

But Dana knew she couldn't do it alone. So, she enrolled in The Morton Center's Concerned Persons Group.

This is a FREE program, funded by wonderful donors. And Dana could take advantage of it when she wasn't working at the hospital.

to start setting boundaries.


I also finally understood addiction is a disease. Mark couldn't just STOP."

Outpatient Program after Dana summoned the
courage to ask him. And he completed the program.



Today, Mark is back in recovery and continues to work with Toya Gatewood, The Morton Center's Clinical Manager. Toya has been seeing Mark through telehealth sessions, to keep them both safe through the pandemic.

"Toya never judges me. She always treats me with respect and care."



They'll continue to need the support of The Morton Center. Mark is still out of work, staying home with the kids. And Dana continues working on the frontlines of the COVID pandemic.

Dana and Mark are a real couple. Although we've changed their names and haven't shown their identities, their story is very real. And because of generous donors, people like you, they were able to receive the addiction support they needed.

When March arrived and Louisville went on lockdown, I knew we had to keep going. We couldn't fail the people that depend on us to overcome addiction or the families that love them. On March 17th, we started providing Telehealth services and we have continued our services 100% through Telehealth since then. Although it's been a challenge, it's been a great success.

2020 brought us an epidemic within the pandemic. Addiction and overdose rates are shocking. We saw a 71% increase in calls for help. Thanks to the kindness of donors and our incredibly hard working staff, we've not had to turn one single person away, regardless of

their ability to pay.

The amazing work donors make possible is placed on the shoulders of our talented staff. And while businesses all over the country were forced to let people go, The Morton Center did not experience one single lay off.

Words cannot convey how grateful I am for the partnerships with generous people, whether recipients of our services, their families, or caring individuals and foundations. They could have easily stopped their support this difficult year. Instead, they chose to think of others.

And because of that, families like Dana and Mark will be saved. They'll experience sobriety. They'll experience healing.


